Glenn Petersen has been employed by Camosun College on an on-call/contract basis for the last 6 years. He has performed a variety of plumbing, gas/pipe fitting jobs during that period. He is always professional in his manner and his work is top quality.

Plumbing work that he has done at the College includes everything from clearing main sewer lines to installing plumbing fixtures, water distillers, to repairing/replacing chemical resistant piping in the Chemistry labs.

Glenn has done gas conversions (from propane) on seven furnaces, six in one of our classroom buildings and the seventh in a greenhouse. This included re-piping, changing burners and bringing them up to the British Columbia Gas Code. During the summer of 1997 Glenn converted three of our pottery kilns from propane to natural gas, this included re-doing the piping from the gas meter to the kilns, re-piping the kilns, changing regulators, designing/installing a new manifold and installing new natural gas nozzles.
